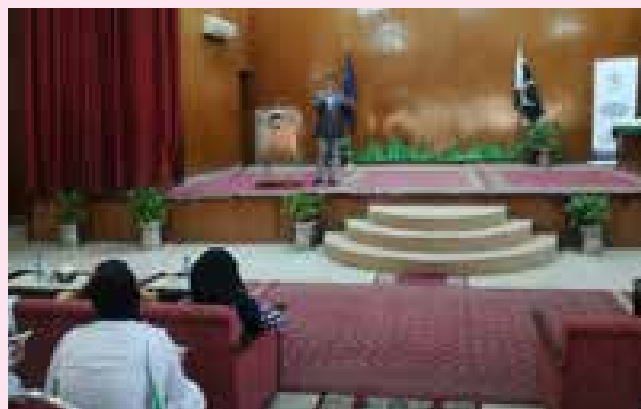
CONTINUATION OF THE SUCCESSFUL OUTREACH PROGRAM- FALL 2022

In continuation with the March Outreach program activities, the Marketing & Admission Department has conducted multiple sessions and activities by representing Riphah International University in various educational institutions. These activities are the extension of the previous month's successful outreach sessions, and the Marketing department is hopeful to arrange more sessions in Fall-2022. Following are the highlights from the outreach activity in March and April.

Career Counselling Session at Islamabad Model College for Girls F-10/2.

On 16th March 2022, the RIU team conducted a successful career counseling session at Islamabad Model College for girls f10/2. In this session, the RIU team interacted with nearly 300 FSC students from Intermediate and briefly guided them about degree programs offered in RIU, the eligibility criteria, fee structure, and the future opportunities provided to them after graduation. RIU team also collected student data for future benefits.



Participation in Student Fair City School and College Islamabad

On 17th March 2022, the Marketing & Admission team participated in the student fair held at City school and college Islamabad. OIC TALK ORGANIZED BY RIPS WITH MR. TAHSIN ERTUGRULOGLU - MINISTER FOREIGN AFFAIR OF TURKISH REPUBLIC OF NORTH CYPRUS



Riphah Institute of Public Policy, RIU in collaboration with IPDS organized a talk of H.E. Mr. Tahsin Ertugruloglu- Minister for Foreign Affairs of Turkish Republic of North Cyprus, with the academicians, scholars, students, and practitioners on 21st March 2022 at RIPS-RIU in Evacuee Trust Building, Islamabad. The main agenda of the talk was to discuss "The Cyprus problem" which is an ongoing dispute between Greek Cypriots and Turkish Cypriots.

The Turkish Foreign Minister, Mr. Tahsin Ertugruloglu stated that, "The Cyprus problem" is a state problem as United Nations is unable to solve the issue and the Turkish government has wasted 53 years in negotiations with the Greek siblings under the UN parameters to establish a federation. He further added that unless and until Turkish Cypriots will not be considered as the equal party to this entire conflict, all the resolutions and analysis will stand unacceptable.

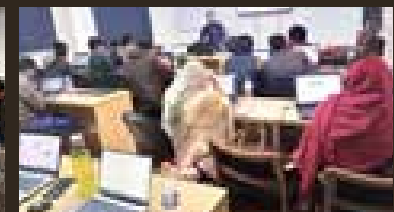


“FREE IT TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION” PROJECT GRANTED TO RISE & METAPI PVT. LTD.

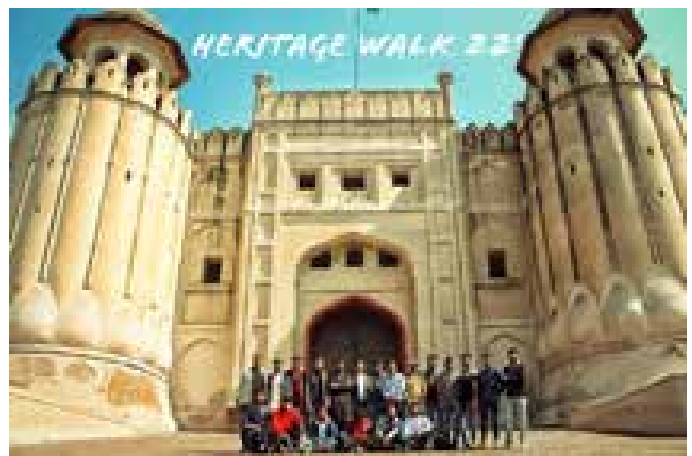

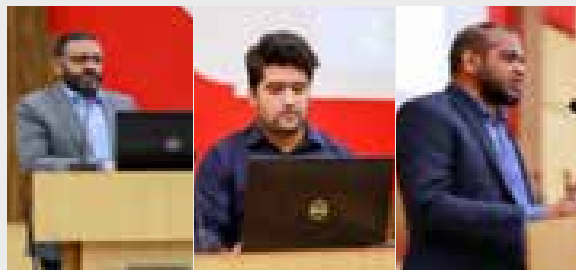
THE TWO-DAY CPD COURSE FOR MLT FACULTY

THE SUCCESS STORY OF IIMCT-PRH AFTER THE INCEPTION OF RHS

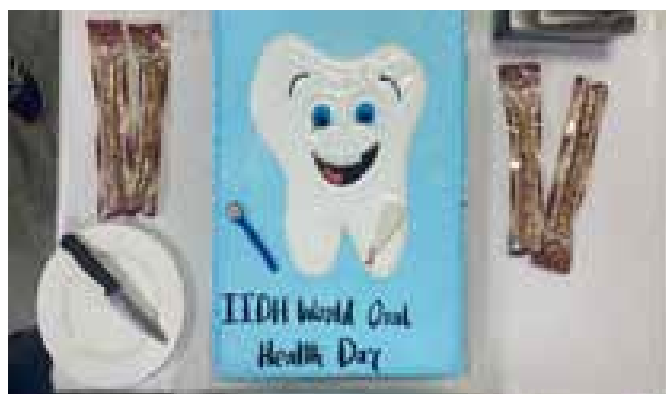
Since RHS's inception, Pakistan Railways Hospital-PRH had shifted its working dynamics 360 degrees with the instilling of young leaders like Dr. Arbaz Waleed (Acting CMS) along with the support of Dr. Omer Awab (DTH), Mr. Asadullah Khan, Executive Director, and eventually, the conspicuous support received from Mr. Hassan Muhammad Khan, (MT). In the previous years, PRH had developed its services from secondary care level to tertiary care and now it is shifting towards specialized care facilities with the introduction of the new procedure and up-to-date equipment. RHS has added a number of services at PRH which include Dialysis, CT-scan, ERCP, Gastroenterology, Cardiology, Plastic Surgery, Urology, Mammography, Interventional Cardiology (in progress), CCU, ICU, Max Pharmacy, Max Pathology, and Blood Bank services, etc.

A handsome amount is spent by RHS higher management on Infrastructure development, Capacity Building, and Equipment up-gradation of the hospital. This resulted in an increased number of paying patients up to 120%, revenue increase up to 200%, achievement in the net income targets up to 100% while a decrease in cost in exceptional times of COVID and at the high inflation rate is observed. However, with the recovery of COVID cases and its reduction in the previous months, the cost of the procedures is improving day by day. RHS-PRH is committed to strive for organizational goals by keeping Islamic ethical values the key part and for providing exceptional healthcare facilities to the patients, Alhamdulillah.

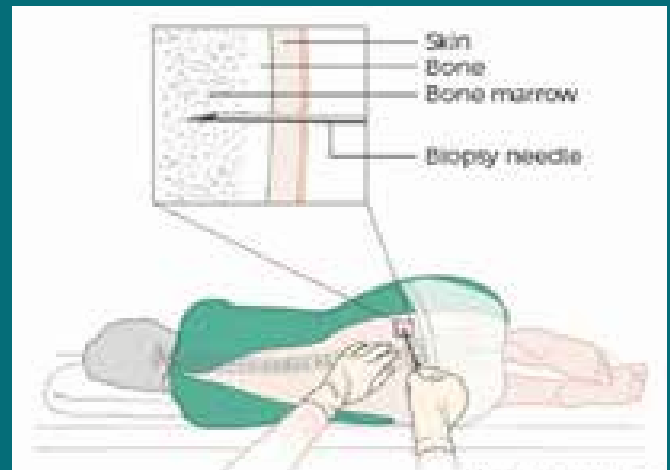


ANOTHER ACHIEVEMENT FOR RIH NEW BONE MARROW BIOPSY PROCEDURE SETUP

Riphah International Hospital has achieved another milestone as RIH has taken a major step toward providing diagnostic facility to Clinicians and patients by starting Bone marrow Biopsy procedures in March 2022. It is a huge Initiative for Postgraduate, Undergraduate students, Lab technologists & Lab technicians to observe and get themselves trained for this procedure. Bone Marrow procedure is a complicated and expensive procedure as 2 main types of bone marrow tests are performed such as bone marrow aspiration and bone marrow trephine biopsy. All medical procedures carry some form of risk, but complications from a bone marrow test are extremely rare. There is less than 1 percent of bone marrow tests that resulted in adverse events.

Patients within the RIU institute and outside can avail this facility. Riphah International Hospital

is hopeful to enhance the healthcare diagnostic facility in Pakistan and make Riphah Groups Proud in the coming years.



FIGHTING DIABETES TOGETHER - FREE CAMP

The Rehabilitation department, Pakistan Railway Hospital in collaboration with the Riphah Social Welfare Department (RSWD) organized a free camp for patients with diabetes from 7th-12th March 2022. A coordinated team from the Rehabilitation department including Physical therapists, Nutritionist, Orthotist, and Prosthetist as well as phlebotomists worked together to guide the patients about regulation and maintenance of glycemic control and prevention of complications of diabetes. Camp activities included free assessment, screening of pulmonary and neurological complications, and consultation

by the Physical therapist focusing on the physical activity of patients and helping them lower their blood sugar levels by taking part in safe and effective exercise programs. A total of 85 patients benefitted through the camp. Camp also provided BMI assessment, free fasting, random blood sugar level tests, and HBA1C test at 50% cost for diabetic patients.
