## INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE WOMEN WELL BEING PROJECT VIRTUAL ICWWB-2022



An International Conference (ICWWB-2022) commenced on the 14th of April 2022 with the title "Reconciling the status of women in the contemporary world" organized by the Women Wellbeing Project, Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities.

ICWWB-2022 had a central theme of addressing the concepts of Women's Well-being from the Islamic perspective aiming at providing a theoretical framework for practical application in the contemporary world. In a nutshell, the goal of organizing this conference at the academic level was to establish the need for understanding the current dilemma where women are struggling to gain their lost identity and attain a social status based on equity and social justice. 10 panelists joined us from other countries out of which 7 were foreign nationals representing countries like Turkey, Malaysia, Lebanon, Morocco, Palestine, Canada, Uganda, and Saudia.

Director WWB Project and Advisor to the VC, Dr. Kouser Firdaus gave a welcome note to the worthy speakers and the audiences. Mr. Hassan Muhammad Khan Chancellor of Riphah International University inaugurated the session with a video message sharing his opinion about the deteriorated family system in the west and its harmful impact on our society. He highlighted the incorporation of Islamic teachings towards resolving family disputes and mentioned them as a leading cause of children having psychological and social issues. He emphasized the need of introducing and improving research in this domain whereby more statistical data could be collected to lead policy making in this area.

Respected VC, Prof. Dr. Anis Ahmad also explained

the objectives of the conference by establishing how academia could be involved in making a change globally. He also talk about ruling out the need to look up to western standards and definitions for resolving women and family disputes. Family Affairs, Food and Ummah, the question of equality between men and women, women family and peaceful coexistence, the gatekeepers; Engaging men in gender justice and prevention of domestic violence, Societal Status of women towards a comprehensive reform, Dispute resolution and challenges towards its implementation, the impact of social media on the wellbeing of women, Role of women in the society, Portrayal of women in the media, Protecting the family for achieving women wellbeing and Muslim women and her role in the social and intellectual development of the society were the main areas elucidated in detail by the notable scholars and researchers presenting at the conference.

The conference (ICWWB-2022) was dedicated to inculcating theory into practice for highlighting and promoting ethical values for resolving issues and responding to challenges. It was established how women can serve as righteous leaders, preserves their public wellness, and emphasizes their roles as a nucleus towards family systems within the Islamic paradigm. This provided an opportunity for scholars, academicians, educationists, and professionals of national and international backgrounds with interdisciplinary and multi-disciplinary interests to bridge the knowledge gap, promote research innovation, develop conceptual understandings, and methods for family systems, and promote collaborative excellence.

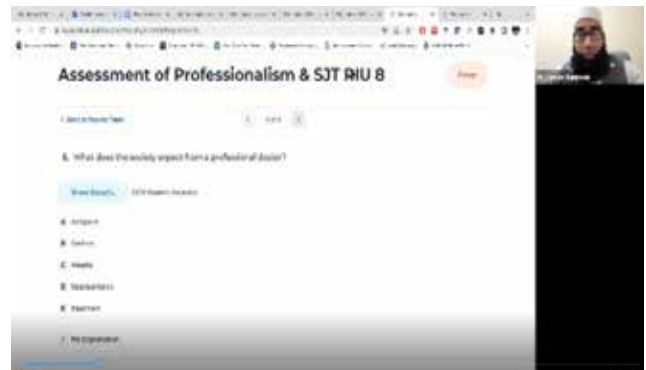

Ministry of Information Technology (IT) and the Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) has granted a project titled “Free IT Training and Certification” to a joint venture of MetaPi Private limited and Riphah Institute of Systems Engineering (RISE) worth PKR. 270 Million. This project will provide training and certifications to 1700 students, professionals, and government employees all over Pakistan (2022).

The professional certifications provided in this project include Certified Ethical Hacking (CEH), Computer

Hacking Forensics Investigation (CHFI), Microsoft Azure, AWS Solutions Architect-Associate (SAA), AWS Solutions Architect-Professional (SAP), Cisco Certified Network Associate (CCNA), and Certified Associate in Python Programming Certification (PCAP).

The project will be executed in two phases. In the first phase, 800 professionals are targeted to be trained. The team RISE has trained 700+ professionals in some cities of Pakistan such as Islamabad, Lahore, Peshawar, Quetta, and Karachi.





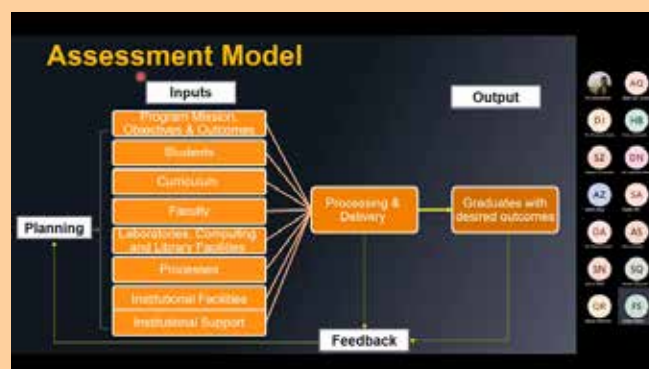
## AWARENESS SESSION ON “PROGRAM SELF-ASSESSMENT”

The findings indicated that tinnitus is common in people with age over 65 years and has a strong association with the risk of falls.

Human Development Services, HDS has organized a one-day learning program on “Business Automation” on Friday, March 25, 2022, in Islamabad. This training session was designed for the RHS Management team, and it helped them to understand a wave of applications of business automation tools to transform organizations to be more efficient, more sustainable, and thus innovative.

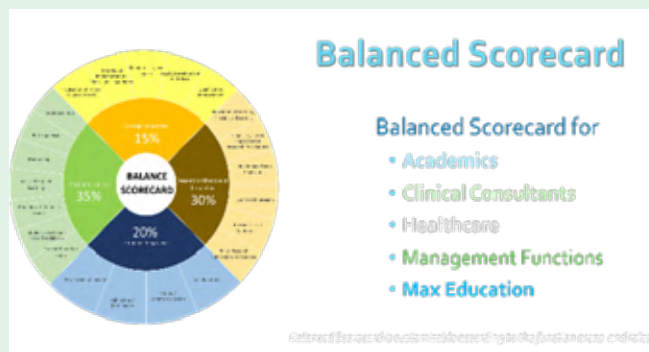
## KPIS AND THE NEED FOR DEVELOPING SMART KPIS

With the support of SUs and RIU leadership, HDS has completed 90% of goal setting for the year 2021-22 at the HRPMS Portal. Goalsetting is completed mainly on the Balanced Scorecard as well as the Managing Targets methodology. This year, around 15 formal training sessions were organized on MS Teams and more than 100 sessions have been conducted in person informally with faculty and management regarding the Balanced Scorecard. Smart dashboards have been developed with the stakeholders to visually elaborate on the different KPIs and their advancement over some time.

To develop the proper understanding of the Key Performance Indicator (KPI) for our diversified users, HDS developed and uploaded a user manual as well as demonstrated the KPI concept in the training sessions through walk-through sessions. Users need to develop the SMART target description to drive the KPIs. It is required in both methodologies.

In continuation, HDS has started the review of the Targets activities of everyone to ensure the linkage of targets with 5-years planning as well as SMART target formulation in the Goal settings.

HDS is actively and continuously improving the HRPMS portal for a better user experience and to achieve comparative insights of performance that guide future actions. In collaboration with the IT department, new changes and improvements are in process.

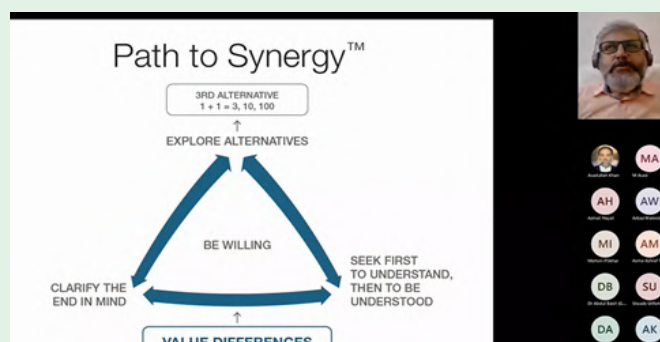


## "CREATIVITY AND INNOVATION" SESSION FOR RHS EXECUTIVE MANAGEMENT
