RIPP ORGANIZED SEMINAR ON FAILED AFGHAN PRESCRIPTION & TALIBAN 2.0: REGIONAL STAKES & IMPLICATIONS



Institute of Public Riphah Policy, Riphah International University, and IPDS jointly organized a Seminar on "Failed Afghan Prescription and Taliban 2.0: Regional Stakes & Implications" on Wednesday, 25th August 2021, at Riphah Institute of Public Policy. Distinguished Speakers from different parts of Pakistan joined the session including; Ambassador (R) Abdul Basit, former High Commissioner of Pakistan to India, Dr. Amna Mahmood Professor/ Dean Faculty of Social Sciences, International Islamic University, Islamabad, Prof. Dr. Syed Hussain Shaheed Soherwordi, Chairman, International Relations University of Peshawar, Dr. Aiysha Safdar, Head, Department of International Relations, Kinnaird College for Women, Lahore., Dr. Rashid Aftab, Director, Riphah Institute of Public Policy, Riphah International University Islamabad and Ms. Farhat Asif, Founder President, Institute of Peace and Diplomatic Studies to share important insight on the ongoing situation in Afghanistan.

It was concluded through the extensive deliberations that, Pakistan is playing a constructive role in peaceful Afghanistan. Pakistan, with its support and noninterference policy stand, always considers that there should be Afghan-led and Afghan-owned solutions to the internal crisis of the country. Speakers of the Seminar were in the consensus that chaotic fall of the Afghan government is a matter of concern for the international community because of the growing humanitarian crisis. They were of the view that the "Neo-Taliban" need to act on their policies of reconciliations, giving rights to women and other commitments to remain engaged at the global scale. It was also highlighted that the Afghanistan crisis results from the failed policies of the previous corrupt Afghan government. The corruption also seeped deep in the society and system of Afghanistan that the Armed forces could not fight the Taliban. Afghanistan's developing political and security concerns demand comprehensive and multilater engagement.

It was also analyzed that, the Afghan situation on three levels: domestic, regional, and international and explained at length the future prospects for regional players in dealing with the Taliban.

It was further added that, in the topic variables are; Afghan Prescription, Taliban2, Impact on Regional Countries. From a historical perspective, three scenarios in Afghanistan were possible in the wake of the US military withdrawal: negotiated settlement, civil war, or Taliban takeover. We are witnessed to the third scenario, however in each; the Taliban is likely to emerge as the most influential party. The Taliban is a revolutionary movement, deeply opposed to the Afghan tribal system and focused on the rebuilding of the Islamic Emirate. Their propaganda and intelligence are efficient, and the local autonomy of their commanders in the field allows them both flexibility and cohesion. They have made clever use of ethnic tensions, the rejection of foreign forces by the Afghan people, and the lack of local administration to gain support in the population. Taliban 2.0 have emerged as more professional and tolerant image and their success is embedded in the fact although US has invested \$83 billion to train the Afghan army but it was not clear to Question Afghans were willing to die for their government.


HDS is pleased to share that we have successfully concluded the Selection Board(s) for Islamabad, Chakdara, and Lahore during the past 2 weeks. In total, 1524 CVs were received, 762 were long listed, 447 were shortlisted, 245 have been shortlisted for initial demos/interviews, 127 candidates were called for the final interviews, and 70 are selected for the final offer (Including Promotions). After the finalization of the Internal Appointment criteria, all candidates for promotions appeared on the selection board.

Out of 70 selected candidates, 26 are foreign qualified i.e. 37%. This translates into a highly competitive 0.3% of the final selection out of the originally applied. Also, during this period, the Appointment/Promotion Criteria of Faculty is implemented for the first time across the Board successfully. 

FMS-RSL REPRESENTATION IN YOUTH LEADERSHIP PROGRAM




FMS-RSL Seminar on Recent Advancements in Project Management Report


FMS-RSL Organized "Ras Model" Session

Customized Learning Program Accounting Standards



- 2. Basic life support training by Rescue 1122 at RIH 24th August 2021.
- 3. Establishment of Dialyses center In Riphah International Hospital:

Fire safety training by Rescue 1122 at PRH on 21st August 2021:

With the vision that safe communities where all citizens are provided the right to timely emergency response and care without discrimination, Riphah social welfare department in collaboration with PRH and Rescue 1122 conducted training on fire safety at PRH on 21th August 2021. The objective of this training was to create awareness among staff of firefighting techniques and the ways to respond swiftly in times of such emergency situations. Mock safety drills and safety procedures to be adopted were explained to staff.

Fire evacuation plans shall include the following:

- 1. Emergency egress or escape routes and whether evacuation of the building is to be complete or, where approved, by selected floors or areas only.
- 2. Procedures for employees who must remain to operate critical equipment before evacuating.
- 3. Procedures for assisted rescue for persons unable to use the general means of egress unassisted.
- 4. Procedures for accounting for employees and occupants after evacuation has been completed.
- 5. Identification and assignment of personnel responsible for rescue or emergency medical aid.
- 6. The preferred and any alternative means of notifying occupants of a fire or emergency.
- 7. The preferred and any alternative means of reporting





fires and other emergencies to the fire department or designated emergency response organization.

- 8. Identification and assignment of personnel who can be contacted for further information or explanation of duties under the plan.
- 9. A description of the emergency voice/alarm communication system alert tone and preprogrammed voice messages, were provided.

Basic life support training by Rescue 1122 at RIH 24th August 2021:

RSWD arranged training of Rescue 1122 at Riphah International Hospital. The training was provided to staff to teach them the basic level support of medical care that can be used for victims of injuries in accidents until they get proper and full medical care at a hospital. MS RIH welcomed the trainers and training recipients and told them about the importance of this training. He further told that after learning these skills we could save lives. BLS in general stands for Basic Life Support. It denotes a level of care that patients will receive in an emergency situation in a wide variety of settings including in-hospital and out of the hospital. CPR is a life-saving technique that is used when someone's heart has stopped. Some medical conditions, such as a severe heart attack, can cause the heart to stop. Other causes include drowning, electric shock, poisoning, overdose, and serious injury. For CPR to be successful, it needs to be started as soon as possible after a person's heart stops. The expert trainer of Rescue 1122, Mr. Emad, and his team shared very important information during this session.

29 participants not only attended the training but also showed interest in participating in demonstrations, especially in CPR.

Establishment of Dialyses center In RIH

In Pakistan, different kinds of fatal diseases are spreading day by day. One of them is a chronic renal failure which has damaged a lot. The Govt. of Pakistan is unable to provide health facilities for such a great number of patients who are suffering from renal diseases because of its limited health budget. Therefore the death toll is increasing day by day. The health facilities for dialysis are not sufficient for so many patients in the Govt. sector hospitals. Most patients die because of this expensive treatment and which they cannot afford, for this purpose Riphah Social Welfare Dept. established Dialysis Welfare Center in RIH, for poor patients with Kidney failure. It's a ray of hope for needy patients of Rawalpindi.
