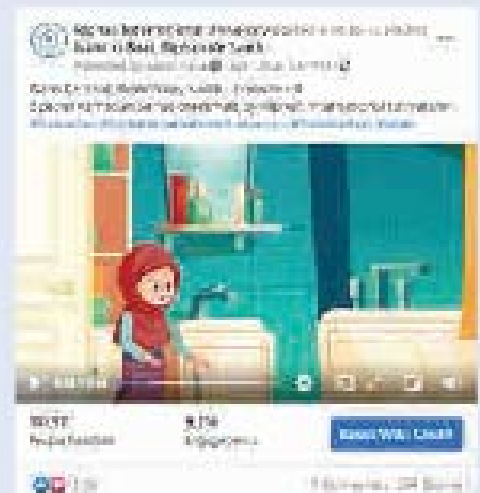
## MARKETING DEPARTMENT DEVELOPED ANIMATION SERIES “NAIKI KI BAAT RIPHAH K SAATH”

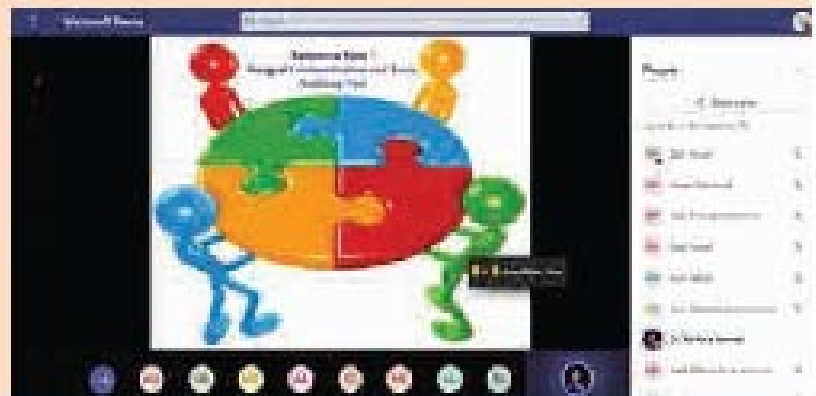
### Myths, Misconception & Fundamentals of Islamic Banking

## RIPP ORGANISED CONSULTATIVE SESSION OF SINGLE NATIONAL EDUCATION & CURRICULUM FRAMEWORK POLICY

Riphah Institute of Public Policy organized a series of consultative sessions as a project to get engaged in the process of National Education & Curriculum Framework policy at school level in last three years with the objectives to review constitutional provisions of education in Pakistan and their reflections in education policies of Pakistan, to explore acts passed and laws formulated in accordance with constitution provisions, Islamic provision of education and to analyze the curriculum development inputs and framework recently developed as Single National Curriculum.

Referring to the curriculum development of project objectives, 3rd Session was held on 27th April 2021 focusing Text book writing policy. Prof Dr Anis Ahmad (Vice Chancellor Riphah International University Islamabad), Mr. Rafique Tahir (Joint Educational Advisor NCS Team, MoFEPT, Pakistan), Mr. Shahid Warsi (Chief Executive Officer AFAQ Pakistan), Dr Tahir Mahmood (Former Director Curriculum Punjab Text Book Board Lahore) and Dr. Rashid Aftab (Director RIPP) joined as keynote speakers. Mr Zubair Safdar moderated the session.

Dr Rashid Aftab welcomed the audience and mentioned that there are parallel education systems and this division is not only affecting the harmony among countries but also the culture of individuals of the same society. This government has taken a good step towards a single national curriculum including guidelines, framework, agreement on common principles, teachers' training etc. RIPP decided to take part in discussion of salient features of education policy.

Dr. Tahir Mahmood (Former Director Curriculum, Punjab Text Book Board) also joined the session and appreciated the efforts being conducted by Riphah University on education policy and curriculum framework. Mr. Shahid Warsi (CEO, Association for Academic Quality - AFAQ) comprehensively analyzed the developments in perspective of curriculum. He also appreciated the positive efforts of Riphah International University regarding curriculum development.

Joint Educational Advisor NCS Team, Ministry of Federal Education Planning & Training, Pakistan, Mr. Rafique Tahir mentioned SNC development

Process is based on the following key aspects: Teaching of Quran & Sunnah, Vision of Quaid & Iqbal, Constitutional framework, National policies, aspiration and national standard, Alignment with the goal, Emerging international trends in teaching learning and assessment, Outcome based approaches, Focus of values, life skill based and inclusive education, Respect and appreciation for different culture and religion in local and global context, Promotion of intellectual, Spiritual, aesthetic, emotional, social and physical development learner etc.

Prof. Dr. Anis Ahmad (Vice Chancellor Riphah International University Islamabad) concluded the whole discussion and stressed that identification of national education goals is very much important. He further added that ideology of Pakistan which is ideology of Islam should be part of national curriculum and Our education should be as per constitutional provision which clearly defines the inculcation of Islamic values.

### Key Policy Perspective:

- 1- Curriculum should be developed as per provision of constitution of Pakistan considering the values of majority population.
- 2- Writers and authors should be trained to write text books as per guidelines by SNC keeping in view the Islamic and Pakistan ideology.
- 3- Ideology of Islam and patriotism should be first priority to develop nation through education system.
- 4- Social Sciences subjects should thoroughly improve with curriculum standards by referring Islamic teaching in each subject.
- 5- Teachers training and assessment system is yet not gently addressed in the policy document which should be treated as priority with implementation.
- 6- National language should be given priority rather than mother or official language as a medium.

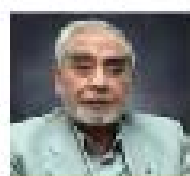
## INTERNATIONAL E-CONFERENCE ON EMERGING TRENDS AND INNOVATIONS IN NANOTECHNOLOGY

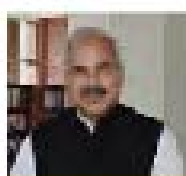
goal was to facilitate networking, collaboration and exchange of ideas with internationally renowned physicists.

## RCIB ORGANIZED WEBINAR ON “DEVELOPMENT OF ISLAMIC MANAGEMENT THEORY”

Riphah Centre of Islamic Business (RCIB) organized a webinar on the “DEVELOPMENT OF ISLAMIC MANAGEMENT THEORY” on April 28, 2021 from 11:00 am to 12:30 pm through ZOOM. The webinar was aimed at discussing Management Theory and exploring how Islamic Management Theory can be developed.

Mr. Ikram Ullah, Senior Lecturer & Editorial Assistant (JIBM) of Riphah Centre of Islamic Business (RCIB) served as host while Prof. Muhammad Ayub, Director Research (RCIB) served as co-host. He has served as Professor and Dean Faculty of Management Sciences AKU (AJ&K), and HOD, Department of Technology Management International Islamic University Islamabad, Associate Professor, Iqra University Islamabad Director of Studies, an institute of higher education in the UK. He has written 63 books out of which 36 are about Islamic Management Style/Theory.

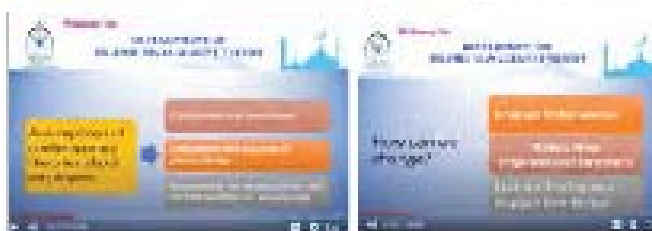
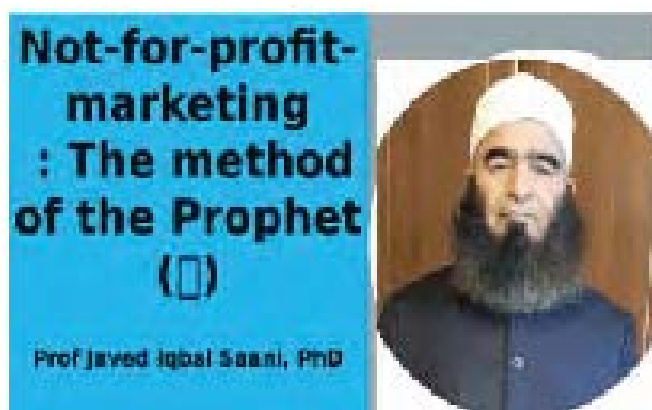
Prof. Dr. Javed Iqbal Saani discussed the contemporary assumptions about the employees that they are considered as “Machines” and not

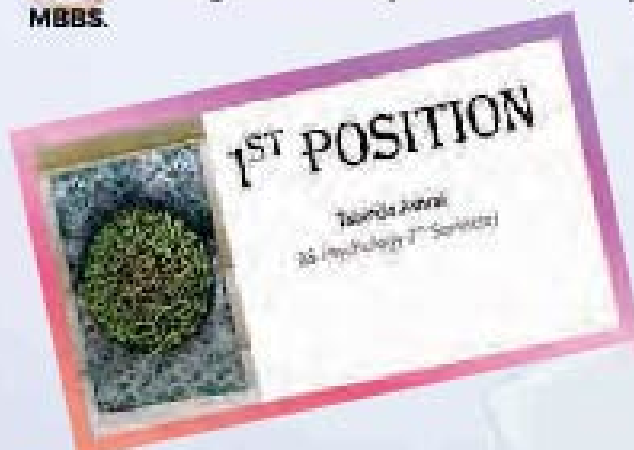

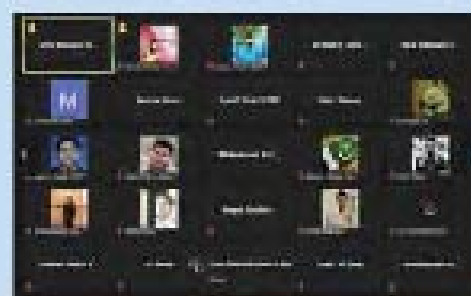
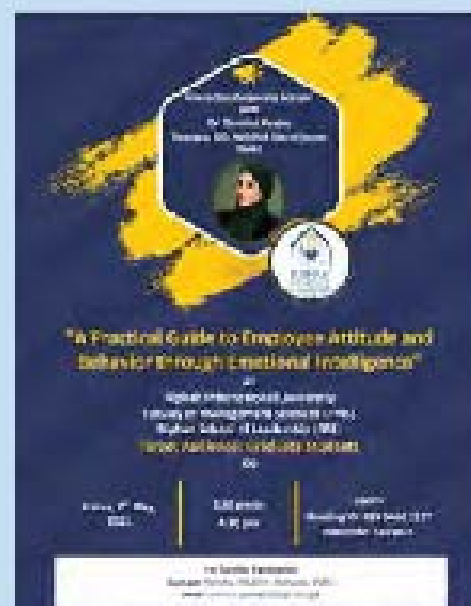

The informative and interactive session enlightened students with a key to unlock their inner potential through emotional intelligence that will assist them in becoming a thorough professional.

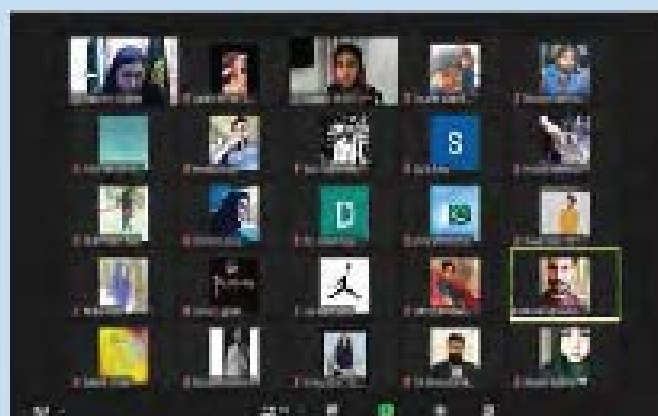
The webinar was moderated by Ms. Rimsha Iqbal, Jr. Lecturer RSL, and was attended by almost 50 graduate students.
