Around 40 world renowned medical educationists graced the event and shared



RIPHAH INSTITUTE OF PUBLIC POLICY LAUNCHED BOOK ON KASHMIR


After the revocation of the semi-autonomous status of the Indian occupied Kashmir by Indian Regime, they also scrapped the local special citizenship law, guaranteed under Article 35 (A) of the Indian constitution. Thousands of Indians have been granted domicile certificates of the valley. This is a plan to shift the demography of the region having very significant implications for the partition plan of 1947 and proposed plebiscite.

Considering the fragile situation in Kashmir and to develop an academic narrative, Riphah Institute of Public Policy (RIPP) decided to write a book entitled "Kashmir: Demographic Shift, Historical Developments and Hindutva".

Kashmir Committee of Parliament House appreciated the efforts of Riphah University and decided to officially launch the book through the platform of the Parliament as an official partner of Riphah as this will be a national contribution of the University to the cause of Kashmir. The launching ceremony of the Book/Monograph was held on the 14th April, 2021 at Jammu Kashmir House, Islamabad.

Mr. Shehreyar Khan Afridi, Chairman, The Parliamentary Special Committee on Kashmir was the Chief Guest on the Occasion and launched the book in the presence of; authors, editors, youth activists, academicians, and scholars. More than 12 TV Channels aired the session live in their respective bulletins.

Dr. Waleed Rasool (Head of Academics, Casmir Committee) gave an opening statement and followed by the welcome note by Dr. Rashid Aftab, Director, RIPP on behalf of Riphah and spotlighted the think tank activities



of RIPP-Riphah. Talking about the book he said, the book is an effort of Riphah to help the government and its Kashmir policy to account for various critical aspects stressed through various chapters of the book includes; Demographic Shift, Indian Interventions and contemporary developments, Basic of Kashmir Economy, Kashmir and Historical Developments ,Demographics of Kashmir, Implementation of law for extra-Judicial killings, Hindutva's Desire of Demographic Change in Indian Occupied Jammu and Kashmir, Hindutva and BJP Nexus, Changing Demography Absorbing J&K, Kashmir Dispute and Risks of Nuclear Conflagration in South Asia and Indian Conventional and Nuclear Doctrines.

Mr. Kashif Zaheer was of the view that it is highly commendable that in addition to the students of RIPP more than 100 activists from different youth organizations joined the book launching ceremony which will strengthen the Kashmir narrative through the mobilization of the youth.

Mr. Shehreyar Khan Afridi appreciated the Riphah and









authors/editors of the book for their efforts as national contribution. He said, Indian Government is implementing the vicious plan of economic terrorism in Kashmir. This book is the proof that, our academic community is highly empowered and capable to unveil the notorious Indian plans and designs of demographic shift in Illegally Indian Occupied Kashmir.

The philosophy of Hindutva is one of the main driving force behind the expansionist policies of India in the region. The Indian government is working to place the hybrid culture to undone the identity and culture of Kashmir. It is duty and responsibility of all academicians, activists and social media user to plead the cause of Kashmir by highlighting its identity and tradition. Prime Minister of Pakistan Imran Khan is fighting the case of Kashmir at every

forum around the globe. We can't get engage with India at the cost of Kashmir. Our politicians, bureaucracy and army are united on the same page. He further added, the reasons of Muslims decline around the globe were lack of unity among them. Indians are changing the demography of Kashmir.

There is severe violation of human rights. The minorities are not safe due to extremists in the India. He said that India can no more keep its illegal occupation of Jammu and Kashmir intact and the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) should materialize its commitment to hold an impartial and free plebiscite to decide about their fate independently. He said Pakistan would keep exposing the Indian expansionist agenda and can no more mislead the world about its expansionist designs in IIOJK.


